LET THE LAWMAKER BE THE JUDGE

I believe that for too long Christians have judged each other out of blindness and ignorance. We have accused others because we think we are right and they are wrong. This has brought divisions between denominations far greater than we can imagine, each believing that they are fully right to condemn another. I have had it said to me that we will judge all things, and the word does say this, but notice the word WILL, will is for the future not know. Now let me say we will judge all things not all people, we judge what they say and do, which is to judge the action according to the word and not to judge the person that is for God to do. We can read to take the log out of our own eye before we try to take the speck out of another's eye. Jesus said let him who is without sin cast the first stone, judge yourself first then if you are perfect judge but beware how you judge.

Do Not Judge (Matt 7:1-5) "Judge not, and you shall not be judged. Condemn not, and you shall not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven. 38 Give and it will be given to you: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom. For with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you." NKJV

I say heed these words for they can mean life in heaven or hell, what a thought. As we judge is how we will be judged and as we condemn is how we will be condemned, we lay the rules down how we are to be judged or condemned by the way we speak of others. We cannot say I judged this way but I must be judged a different way, no we will be treated according to how we have treated others. Forgive and you will be forgiven. WOW we have a choice judge or forgive, if we forgive others for what they do and say we will be forgiven when we stand before God. God has given us a way out of condemnation and He will judge us forgiven (innocent), what a promise in verse 38, give and it will be given to you. O my friends let us be givers not out of our excess, but abundant givers, give of your very self for our Lord gave His all for us and triumphed, so can we. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over pressed into your bosom. Is this what we want our bosom filled with God's love so much that it runs out of us? If we can just take hold of this we can cause the world to change, for every where we go God's blessing will flow out of us touching the hurting, lost and discouraged. We can give of our wealth that is easy but when we give of ourselves that can be hard, but God will refresh us. But the verse ends with that same warning; the measure we use will be measured out to us. We have been given a free will let it be used right.

Rom 14:4 "Who are you to judge another's servant? To his own master he stands or falls. Indeed, he will be made to stand, for God is able to make him stand". NKJV

Who are we to judge another's servant? What a question, How can we judge what is not ours to judge? It is for God to judge a man's heart not us. We cannot tell God to exalt or condemn, as I said before we judge what is said or done not the heart for only God knows what is in a man's heart.

Rom 14:10-13 "But why do you judge your brother? Or why do you show contempt for your brother? For we shall all stand before the judgment seat of Christ. 11 For it is written: "As I live, says the Lord," Every knee shall bow to Me, And every tongue shall confess to God.".. Is it right to stand against a brother or sister because we believe or have been taught differently from our birth and believe those who have taught us? We need to show them love and welcome them, show them by the word of God but be open to also learn from them, for all of us do not know everything and we all are making mistakes each day. Remember as we judge so we will be judged. So then each of us shall give account of himself to God. 13 Therefore let us not judge one another anymore, but rather resolve this, not to put a stumbling block or a cause to fall in our brother's way. Each of us will stand before God and have to answer for ourselves, to explain why we have persecuted a brother or sister, I say try not to be a stumbling block but an encourager. Do we want our bosom filled to overflow? Then we need to bless with the love of God that is in us. It is no good singing the songs of praise and worship with bitterness in our hearts towards our fellow man. That last sentence can be a hard one for in the past I have been like this and my words have tasted bitter to me let alone God. We cannot praise God whilst judging another brother or sister, we are like clanging cymbals, just an empty noise, Praise and worship come out of love and if we hold things against those whom God loves we are not worthy to praise

and worship Him. So let us resolve our differences even if we agree to differ, allow God to judge and let us love even when it seems impossible. James 4:12 "There is one Lawgiver, who is able to save and to destroy. Who are you to judge another?" So let us allow the one who made the law judge by the law, for the one who can destroy both body and spirit can also raise it up. When we stand in heaven next to the ones we have persecuted, how do we answer when God asks us to give an account of why we persecuted this or that person? Remember by the answer we give we will be judged and found guilty or innocent.

My prayer for myself and those who read this is that we will all determine not to judge or condemn the heart of another and that God will help each one of us to do this. To seek the truth and encourage each other, to allow God to convict and lead others to the truth through our overflow of love so that we do not condemn our brothers and sisters. I find it hard not to point the finger, but when I do I find three pointing back at me declaring my guilt, so let us have open hands to each other and not wagging fingers, let us receive conviction and not condemnation, and let us love from the fullness of our bosom.
